

Dogs on Site

Dear members, given the diverse nature of our membership, including members of all ages, it has been decided that we must have a policy for presence of dogs on site. This is to address both a question of hygiene and the reality that not all people are comfortable with dogs around their persons and their children, however well trained the dogs are.

Considering that there is no particular need for dogs on site, except under certain specific circumstances, we are asking that dog owners follow the below guidelines if they wish to bring their animal onto the site :

1. Dogs are not permitted within the Clubhouse building, all areas both on the ground floor and on the upper floor.
2. Any dog fouling must be cleared up immediately and disposed of properly
3. Dogs must be kept on leads AND closely supervised, at all times – leaving them tied up does not count as close supervision.

There may be special circumstances where a member requires the assistance of a dog whilst on site – please first check with your captain, explaining the circumstances and secure their agreement. Members do have the right to check if you have received permission given the above conditions, please be patient of these checks.
